### *Who is TVF?*

True Volunteer Foundation (TVF) is a unique international non-governmental organisation which last year directly impacted over 110,000 people with projects across 28 countries.

### *What is our main goal?*

The Foundation has a primary goal of irradicating poverty, suffering and environmental damage by empowering people through education.

### *How do we do that?*

TVF provides a range of educational services including building schools, capacity building for micro-finance entrepreneurs, large-scale health projects, and addressing environmental and animal welfare concerns.

### *How do we fund that?*

TVF raises funds by providing tailored Corporate Social Responsibility solutions to companies and high net worth individuals. No charges are levied for these services.



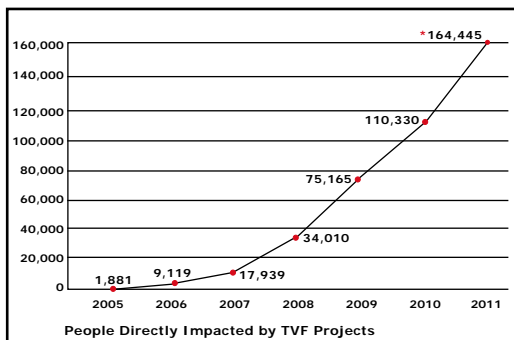
## How is TVF managed?

Over 100 True Volunteers, who 'Pay to Work', run TVF. True Volunteers do not receive any wages, commissions, or even reimbursement of personal expenses. TVF provides a unique platform for True Volunteers to realise their Personal Social Responsibility objectives, working from home, the office or in the field.

True Volunteers engage in a "social career" donating between five to thirty-five hours per week to TVF.

## Strategic Projects

TVF is involved in self-sustaining projects which empower the whole community. The Gampaha Regeneration programme in Sri Lanka included the building of two acres of new facilities for a rural community. This included an integrated farm to provide employment, and a host of educational facilities. Similarly, the Madagascar IT Programme will educate over 1 million people over a 5-year period.
