The True Volunteer Foundation (TVF) organisation is made up of different age groups, skill-sets and experience levels. The common bond being their dedication to the cause. True Volunteers include companies' staffs who are allowed to work for TVF during allocated hours; full-time staff provided grants by the European Union, part-time professionals, students, migrant workers, housewives, the unemployed and the retired. True Volunteers work together through a next generation Extranet from countries as far a field as China and the Philippines. The opportunity exists for students to perform work placements at TVF, working at TVF's

offices or remotely from their University Campus' through TVF's purpose built Extranet. TVF currently has many students volunteering for TVF in a number of disciplines including graphic design, finance, information technology, marketing, proposal writing, video editing, research and fundraising. TVF are aiming to partner with select Universities to have their work integrated within the syllabus of certain qualifications such as Master's Degree in Business (MBA) and Corporate Social Responsibility. Enrolling in such programmes can be part of a Universities' Corporate Social Responsibility Programme whilst providing a pragmatic element to their courses and real-life experience for their students. TVF is currently partnered with Universities in the U.K. and Europe; directly and part of a number of European Union educational initiatives.
